Gakko is dedicated to artful design, collaborative production, and immersive world-building of camps that educate, inspire wonder, cultivate authenticity, and reverberate generosity around the world. Through fifteen programs in seven years, the Gakko camp project impacted over 700 individuals from more than 65 nations. Oversaw all aspects of producing eight international high school summer programs over three years in Japan, France, Romania, Indonesia and USA. Spearheaded a rigorous admission process for program directors and counselors, reviewing >300 applications each year to select a diverse ensemble of 10 counselors for each program. Articulated high-level mission, vision, values of project and developed process by which program curricula and schedules are designed responsively, site-specifically by directors and counselors. Oversaw admission process for participating high school students, including marketing efforts and hundreds of video interviews.
